Dear Bardon families,

Please find attached your child's year level booklists for 2025. When viewing the booklists, you will notice that it is made up of four sections:

1. Bulk Deliveries These products are delivered directly to the school for classroom

use. They won't come in your book pack.

2. List A Items on "List A" are new products <u>required for the year level in</u>

<u>2025</u>.

3. List B Items on "List B" are products required for the year level in 2024 that

you may already own from a previous booklist purchase and could reuse. You are encouraged to check this list and cross off any items that you already own, prior to ordering. This will ensure we are kind

to the environment and to your hip pocket!

4. School Purchase This section lists school items your child may need to purchase

directly from the school, unless you have these from a previous year, such as a library bag and homework satchel. These can now

be purchased from the uniform shop or on QKR!

It is really important for students in Year 3-6 to have a **trusted pair of headphones** (it also helps if they come in a small bag/case to protect them). The booklist asks for a pair **with a microphone**. This will allow students the best access for classroom learning.

You can order your booklist through *SchoolStuff* or shop for the items yourself. If you use *SchoolStuff*, you can:

- Order Online: Click on 'Order Booklists' on the SchoolStuff website and follow the prompts. It is recommended to order all sibling booklists on the same order, to lower delivery costs.
- **Shop and Go INSTANT service:** Shop instore at 83 Proprietary St, Tingalpa 4173, and WAIT while their staff pick and pack your order. You will then proceed to the checkout and take your order with you. Prices in store MAY VARY from your online ordering form. All schools have signed an agreement that delayed deliveries may require some brands to be replaced.
