Aims

Bardon State School believes that a Uniform Policy is important for the following reasons:

- Create a sense of unity as a team and increase school spirit
- Give students a sense of identity with the school
- Provide an opportunity for parents and staff to instil in students a sense of pride in their appearance and their school
- Reduce competition related to appearance and accessories and maintain a focus on learning
- Provide sun safe clothing and hats to promote healthy messages
- Reduce incidents and accidents related to the wearing of jewellery and accessories

Implementation

Students must be in full school uniform at all times unless indicated otherwise by the school

This includes:

- travelling to and from school
- at school
- when representing the school off-campus
- If there is a legitimate reason for a student being unable to wear the uniform, the student is required to present a note/email from parent/s to the Principal explaining the issue and the timeframe for resolving the concern
- Our Uniform Policy strives to support inclusive practices. Parent/s and Carers should seek permission in writing from the Principal to request approval for the wearing of any additional clothing or jewellery items of a cultural or religious significance that is not listed as part of our uniform list

Safety

- **Sun Safety**

In accordance with our *No Hat, No Play* policy, all students must wear a school hat when outside. Students in Years 1 to 6 are required to wear the navy broad-brimmed hat, while Prep students wear the green bucket hat. Students without a hat will be asked to stay in a designated indoor area during outdoor activities.

- **Swimming**

Students need a swim suit, sun shirt (Rashie), towel, swimming bag, swimming cap, goggles and suitable walking shoes (no thongs) each swimming lesson. No jewellery is permitted in the pool.



- **Student Representative Council (SRC) Days**

Throughout the year the SRC holds a number of Non-Uniform Days to raise money for charity. Monies collected are used by the SRC to support a range of projects. On these days clothing must be sunsafe (sleeved shirts). Clothing should only have school age appropriate imagery or text. Only closed shoes are to be worn.

- **Jewellery**

Students can wear one plain watch. Students with pierced ears are permitted to wear one pair of plain sleepers or studs, one in each ear. Necklaces, rings, bracelets or any other jewellery/accessories are not allowed at any time and pose a safety risk

General

- Senior School students (Year 6) may wear their **senior school shirt** at any time
- **Sport House Colour shirts** are optional for students and are worn on Sports Carnivals and other days directed by the school. (Ruby - Red; Topaz - Yellow; Emerald - Green)
- **Hair** must be neat and tidy and of natural hair colouring only. Hair below the collar must be tied back. Fringes should be away from the eyes. No extreme haircuts, for example; tracks, mohawks or extreme shaving
- **Make-up and/or Nail Polish** are not to be worn
- **Adornments** other than BSS school badges are not to be worn with the uniform
- **Temporary Tattoos/Henna** must not be visible

Footwear



Students should wear plain black or plain white, low top, closed in, lace up, velcro or buckle shoes.

Shoes should have sufficient grip for running safely on a variety of surfaces.

Laces must match shoe colour.
