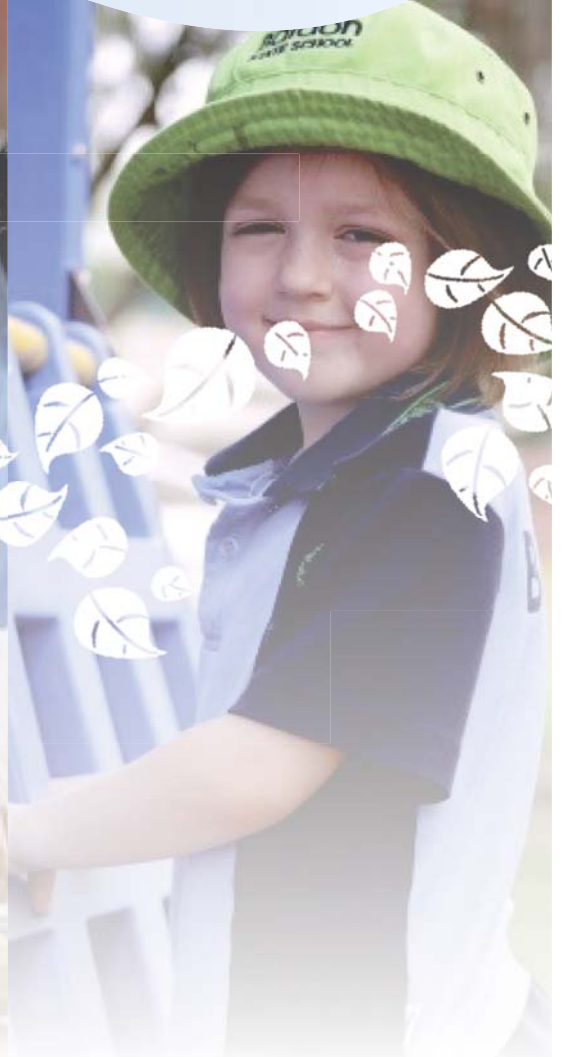

Bardon State School Uniform Policy

Reviewed and endorsed by P&C 19th November 2018. Updated at the P&C 18th March 2019

Aims

Bardon State School believes that a Uniform Policy is important for the following reasons:

- To create a sense of unity as a team and increase school spirit
- Give students a sense of identity with the school
- To provide an opportunity for parents and staff to instil in students a sense of pride in their appearance and their school
- Reduce competition related to appearance and accessories and maintain a focus on learning
- Provide sun safe clothing and hats to promote healthy messages
- Reduce incidents and accidents related to the wearing of jewellery and accessories

Implementation

- Students must be in full school uniform at all times unless indicated otherwise by the school
This includes:
 - travelling to and from school
 - at school
 - when representing the school off-campus
- If there is a legitimate reason for a student being unable to wear the uniform, the student is required to present a note/email from parent/s to the Principal explaining the issue and the timeframe for resolving the concern
- Our Uniform Policy strives to support inclusive practices. Parent/s and Carers should seek permission in writing from the Principal to request approval for the wearing of any additional clothing or jewellery items of a cultural or religious significance that is not listed as part of our uniform list

Safety

- **Sun Safety**

The navy broad brimmed school hat must be worn whenever outside. We follow a *No Hat No Play Policy* whereby students without a hat are required to sit at the stage area during eating time and move to the NO Hat NO Play seat (green seat under B Block).

The Preps are to wear the Green bucket hat when outside. (See BSS website for full SunSmart Policy)

- **Swimming**

Students need a swim suit, sun shirt (Rashi), towel, swimming bag, swimming cap and suitable walking shoes (no thongs) each swimming lesson. No jewellery is permitted in the pool.



- **Student Representative Council (SRC) Days**

Throughout the year the SRC holds a number of Non-Uniform Days to raise money for charity. Monies collected are used by the SRC to support a range of projects. On these days clothing must be sunsafe (sleeved shirts). Clothing should only have school age appropriate imagery or text. Closed shoes only

- **Jewellery**

Students can wear one plain watch. Students with pierced ears are permitted to wear one pair of plain sleepers or studs, one in each ear. Necklaces, rings, bracelets or any other jewellery/accessories are not allowed at any time and pose a safety risk

General

- **Senior School students** (Year 6) can wear their senior school shirt at any time
- **Sport House Colour shirts** are optional for students and are worn on Sport Carnival and other days directed by the school. (Red-Ruby, Yellow-Topaz, and Green-Emerald)
- Students' **hair** must be neat and tidy and of natural hair colouring only. Hair below the collar must to be tied back. Fringes should be away from the eyes. No extreme haircuts for example; tracks, mohawks or extreme shaving
- **Make-up and/or Nail Polish** are not to be worn
- **Adornments** other than BSS school badges are not to be worn with the uniform
- Temporary Tattoos/Henna must not be visible

Consequences – Non Compliance to BSS Uniform Policy

During the enrolment process, the Bardon State School's Responsible Behaviour Plan, Prospectus, Uniform Policy and a range of other key policies and guidelines are provided and these expectations are outlined in relation to uniform and behaviour expectations. It is a condition of enrolment that an Enrolment Agreement is signed by both students and parents indicating that they have read and understood their responsibilities and are agreeing to abide by the expectations when attending Bardon State School.

At Bardon State School we make systematic efforts to prevent inappropriate or unacceptable behaviour by teaching and reinforcing expected behaviours on an ongoing basis. Adherence to our Uniform Policy is part of the expectations of the school. When breaches of the Uniform Policy occur, it is important that consequences are predictable. Our school seeks to ensure that responses to inappropriate or unacceptable behaviour are consistent and proportionate to the nature of the behaviour.


The following is a **guide** to the processes in place following a breach/es of the Uniform Policy


Example of Breach of Uniform Policy	Consequences may include
Single incident of non-compliance to Uniform Policy Removal of item in breach of the Uniform Policy in line with the Temporary Removal of Student Property by School Staff .	'Uniform Policy Breach Notice Minor' (see Appendix A) sent home with student for parent signature Parent to collect from office Time out of playground ie No Hat No Play seat
Off – campus event - student not in Full School Uniform	Student not in full school uniform is not permitted to leave the school grounds to represent the school. This includes excursions, sporting events, etc.
Serious Breach of the Uniform Policy and/or continued breaches of Uniform Policy	<i>Uniform Policy Breach Notice Major</i> (See Appendix B) sent home with student for parent to sign and confirm action to rectify continued uniform breach Where students fail to or refuse to comply with consequences imposed as a result of a failure to meet the standards set out in this uniform policy that may amount to a disciplinary issue, it will be dealt with in accordance with the school's Responsible Behaviour Plan. This may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Withdrawal from playground privileges or extra-curricula school activities • Loss of school representation • Withdrawal from participation in any curriculum activities requiring WPHS compliant footwear/sun-safe wear, including incursions, excursions, science, art, sporting activities etc. • Contact home to parents • Time out at the office • Temporary removal of property



*Parents/carers to contact Principal/ Deputy Principal if there are any circumstances that may be impacting a situation.
